

Summary

The sermon focuses on understanding the purpose and relevance of God's law as found in the Old Testament, particularly in Exodus. The pastor explains three categories of biblical laws: ritual laws (fulfilled in Christ), civil laws (specific to ancient Israel), and moral laws (still applicable today). He emphasizes that while the law cannot save us, it serves to show our sin, demonstrate our need for a Savior, and lead us to Christ.

5. How do the Ten Commandments serve as 'guardrails' in our lives today?

7. How does understanding our inability to keep the law perfectly help lead us to Christ?
8. What's the difference between trying to earn salvation through law-keeping versus obeying God out of love and gratitude?

Life Application

This week, when you encounter a moral decision or ethical dilemma, take time to consider God's commandments not as restrictive rules but as loving guardrails for your protection. Journal about how viewing God's laws this way changes your perspective on obedience.
